- Teams are to register their arrival on the day by 9.30am.
- All players must attend the event briefing at 9.45am on the courts outside the Kaiapoi High School gymnasium.
- First games will begin at 10.00am.

ENTRY FEES: Registration fee is \$15.00 per team. Teams must register and pay the entry fee by Monday 10th May. Drop registration form and payment (cash only) to the All Together Kaiapoi office, 24 Sewell Street Kaiapoi or, email registration form to: alltogetherkaiapoi@gmail.com and then direct credit payment to: All Together Kaiapoi, 03 1585 0128775 00 (using TEAM NAME as the reference.)

- Teams are encouraged to come dressed up. There will be a prize awarded to the best dressed team.
- A 3 point shoot-out competition will take place before the finals. Registrations will be taken on the day
- Each player must wear appropriate footwear. No shoes, no play.
- Mouth guards are recommended to be worn while playing.
- Teams are guaranteed to play a minimum of 3 games.
- The KYDz 3 x 3 basketball tournament is a limited entry event (maximum capacity of 12 teams per category). Priority will be given to teams who reside in the Kaiapoi, Pines Beach and Kairaki areas.
- No refunds will be given to teams cancelling their registration.
- Cancellation – KYDz and All Together Kaiapoi will offer a 50% refund of entry fees per team in the event that the tournament is cancelled due to forces outside of the organisers control such as weather. However, we will do our best to postpone the event. Postponement date is Sunday 30th May.
- No registrations will be accepted on the day.

PLEASE READ THE BACK OF THIS REGISTRATION FORM CAREFULLY

3 x 3 Rules of the Game:

- The game will be played on a 3x3 basketball court (half standard sized court) with 1 basket.
- A size 6 ball will be used for all categories.
- Each team will consist of 3 players. No substitutes will be permitted unless an injury or sickness occurs. Substitute player must be of equal or less ability to whom they are replacing (at event organisers discretion).
- The game officials will consist of 1 referee, 1 time keeper and 1 score keeper.
- No time-outs will be permitted.
- One paper, scissors, rock game shall determine which team gets the first possession. The team that wins can either choose to benefit from the ball possession at the beginning of the game or at the beginning of a potential overtime.
- 1 point for every successful shot inside the arc and successful free throw. 2 points for every successful shot behind the arc.
- Possession changes after every basket.
- Regular playing time will be 10 continuous minutes however, if a team reaches the score limit of 21 before the 10 minutes playing time, they win the game.
- If the score is tied at the end of the 10 minutes playing time, there shall be an interval of 1 minutes before overtime starts. The first team to score 2 points in the overtime wins the game.
- Stalling or failing to play actively (i.e. not attempting to score) is a violation. Teams must attempt a shot within 12 seconds. The referee has the right to appoint 1 point to the opposing team should teams be deliberately abusing this rule.
- There will be a limit of 6 team fouls per game. The penalty for team fouls 6, 7, 8 and 9 will be 2 free throws and the penalty for team fouls 10 and more will be 2 free throws a + ball possession.
- 1 free throw will be awarded after a shooting foul inside the arc and 2 free throws awarded after a shooting foul if foul committed behind the arc.
- Possession:
 - Following a successful goal – defense possession, right underneath the hoop, ball to be passed to a player behind the arc
 - Following a dead ball – check ball exchange behind the arc (at the top)
 - Following a defensive rebound or steal – ball to be passed behind the arc

Team Waiver and Disclaimer (to be signed by all team members)

If any competitor is aged under 13 years old, their parent/caregiver is required to sign as well
